### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT NEW COURSE FORMAT

All students MUST pass the NRP Online Exam PRIOR to attending an in-person, four hour simulation-based practice session. The NRP Online Examination, 6th Edition assesses knowledge of the causes, prevention, and management of mild to severe neonatal asphyxia. After studying the NRP textbook, learners take the online examination via HealthStream. Upon successful completion of the online examination, learners will print the verification of completion and present it to their NRP instructor for skills training, simulation, and debriefing. This MUST be completed PRIOR to attending the in person simulation portion of the course. Please note that the online exam cannot be completed more than 30 days prior to class and once started, it must be completed within 14 days.

#### Parking:
