If you must cancel your registration a refund, excluding the deposit amount, will be provided as long as you notify the Center in writing more than one week prior to the start of the course. No refund will be issued past that time.

Preparation for Class:

The PALS Provider Recertification Course is designed to teach and review the lifesaving skills required to be both a team member and a team leader in either an in-hospital or out-of-hospital setting.

The PALS course covers extensive material in a short period of time so it is **IMPERATIVE** that you will need to prepare for the course beforehand.

You should prepare for this course as follows:

1. You are expected to read the PALS Provider Manual prior to attending the course.
2. Pre-course checklist: Complete the pre-course checklist that came with your PALS Course guide, **Bring checklist to the course**
3. CPR competency: Be prepared to pass the child 1 rescuer CPR/AED and Infant 1 & 2 rescuer CPR skills test. You will not be taught how to do CPR or how to use an AED. You **must know** in advance. The resuscitation scenarios require that your BLS skills and knowledge be current. Review and understand all BLS 2005 guidelines, especially related to the pediatric patient.
4. Self-assessment CD-based test (required): Complete the self-assessment test on the student CD and print your score. **This must be completed prior to the course and handed in at registration.** The test includes ECG recognition, pharmacology and practical application. Use this to identify areas where you need to increase your knowledge.
5. Practice Cases: Work through the practice cases on the student to CD to familiarize yourself with assess-categorize-decide-act” model used in the course.
6. PALS algorithms and flowcharts: Be familiar with the PALS algorithms and flowcharts that you can apply in the clinical scenarios. **You MAY use the PALS algorithm cards** provided in your packet in the practice and testing scenarios.
7. Supplement knowledge: Review the PALS Provider Manual and Course Guide. Pay attention to the systematic approach to pediatric assessment.
8. Course Agenda will be provided upon arrival at the course.

It is essential that you bring your PALS Course Guide to class; you will need it during each lesson in the course.

Cancellation Policy:
