This 3-day collaborative simulation facilitators course is an interactive problem-solving workshop designed to allow you to work with simulation experts to meet your educational objectives. Keynote speakers will address national trends followed by interactive sessions where participants will engage in hands-on learning, acquire, and practice new skills and work together as a team.

**Targeted Audience:** The workshop is designed for physicians, nurses, pharmacists, and other members of the healthcare team at the novice to advanced beginner levels who are interested in using simulation in healthcare education.

- Apply the fundamentals and theories in simulation-based education in their practice
- Create a comprehensive simulation exercise utilizing the step-by-step approach in simulation design
